While there, Hazel Herren spent a few days with her son Randel at his home in San Diego.

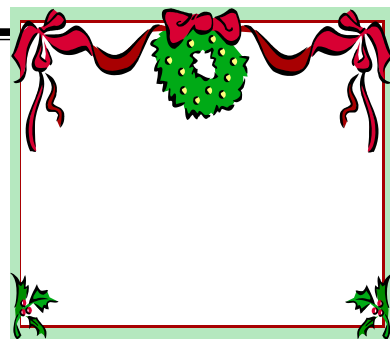


Slating Future Family Reunion
